The Gift of Reading

To second grade families...

Our December take-home project is a book report. The report will take the form of a gift box, wrapped and filled with items to prompt your student during their presentation to the class. Please read the requirements carefully and have fun discovering the gift of reading together with your child!

Students should choose a "Good-Fit" book to read. You may choose a book that you have recently read, or one that you can easily read before the project is due.

With parent help, students will:

- 1. Take a shoe box, or box with a separate top, and wrap it like a present. **Wrap the top separately** so that items may be placed inside and retrieved for the presentation. You may add ribbons and bows.
- 2. Use the LARGE gift tag provided to include student's NAME, the TITLE and AUTHOR of the book.
- Collect or make objects or pictures to represent the following Story Elements:
 - a. Setting
 - b. Main Characters
 - c. Problem and Solution
 - d. Your favorite part of the book
- 4. There must be at least 4 items in the box, use the SMALL gift tags provided to label the items.
- 5. On the inside of the top of the box, fill out the attached page listing or picturing events that happened in the BEGINNING, the MIDDLE, and the END.
